Eiffage acquires several Fayat Group quarries in Occitania¹

Eiffage, via Eiffage Route, has acquired several quarry sites from Razel-Bec (Fayat Group) in Occitania.

Located close to Agen in Lot-et-Garonne and Muret in Haute-Garonne, these sites produce approximately 800,000 tonnes of alluvial materials per year.

With about 30 employees, they generate annual revenues of €8 million.

These acquisitions will enable Eiffage Route to densify its local presence on the aggregates market in South-West France.
