Eiffage as leader of a consortium with Saipem has been awarded by BP to perform the marine infrastructures of the LNG Hub/Terminal of the Greater Tortue Ahmeyim Project, offshore Senegal / Mauritania, with an EPCI contract just over 350 M€ for Eiffage scope

Eiffage through its subsidiary Eiffage Génie Civil Marine as leader of a consortium with Saipem, has just been awarded by BP to perform the EPCI (Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Installation) contract for the Hub/Terminal for BP's Greater Tortue Ahmeyim Field Development Phase 1, a major offshore LNG project located on the maritime border of Mauritania and Senegal, for a contract amount of just over 350 M€ for Eiffage portion.

This Contract has been awarded further to the execution of the Front End Engineering Design (FEED) contract started in April 2018. Eiffage and Saipem worked in a collaborative approach with BP on optimizing the design of the marine infrastructures, matured the execution plan, and prepared the launching of EPCI Phase.

The near-shore Hub/Terminal marine infrastructure is encompassing berthing facilities for a permanently moored FLNG, the loading of LNG Carriers, and an offshore breakwater to shelter those facilities.

The execution plan, as developed by Eiffage, incorporates significant elements of local content in both Mauritania and Senegal, with the aim of enhancing capabilities in those two countries.

The 21 concrete caissons (16 500 t each), forming the breakwater will be built by Eiffage in Dakar (Senegal). In addition, the 2.5 million tons of quarry materials required for the underwater rumble mound for the caissons bed is expected to be produced, transported and loaded for installation from Mauritania.



The initial subsea infrastructure connects via production pipelines to a floating production, storage, and offloading (FPSO) vessel. From there, liquids are removed and the export gas is transported via pipeline to the floating liquid natural gas (FLNG) hub terminal where the gas is liquefied.

The Tortue Ahmeyim Field Development is located in the C-8 block offshore Mauritania and the Saint-Louis Profond block offshore Senegal.
